

808-812 MEMORIAL DRIVE SCHOLARSHIP FUND

The 808-812 Memorial Drive Scholarship Fund was established in 2008 to provide financial assistance to residents 808-812 Memorial Drive, Cambridge who are pursuing higher education. Scholarship applicants are eligible to receive assistance for the full term of their education at a two or four year accredited, degree-awarding institution. However, priority will be given to students entering their first year of school. Graduate school students are not eligible. Awards are expected to be a minimum of \$1,000.

Eligibility Requirements:

In order to be eligible for the 808-812 Memorial Drive Scholarship Fund, the following requirements must be met:

- Must reside in a rent-assisted apartment at 808-812 Memorial Drive
- Must be attending or have received admittance to a two or four year accredited, degree-awarding institution of higher achievement
- Demonstrated financial need
- Demonstrated academic promise and achievement
- Demonstrated community service and community involvement
- An interview may be required

Application Submission Documents:

- Completed application form
- Transcript of grades from high school or college
- Proof of acceptance (acceptance letter/verification of enrollment)
- Letter of recommendation from a teacher
- Copy of financial aid award letter from college
